1.	Would you vote to repeal the transgender laws passed in 2011 and 2016 that have been used to open bathrooms to all genders in the public schools, and women’s locker rooms to men?	<b>UNK</b>	<b>NO</b>
2.	Would you support the elimination of all tax-payer funding for Planned parenthood, redirecting those dollars to community health centers?	<b>NO</b>	<b>NO</b>
3.	Would you support the Religious Beliefs and Moral Convictions Protection Act which would prohibit discriminatory action against a person, whether as parent, employee, business, religious leader or religious organization, on the basis of acting or declining to act in accordance with a sincerely held religious belief or moral conviction?	<b>NO</b>	<b>NO</b>
